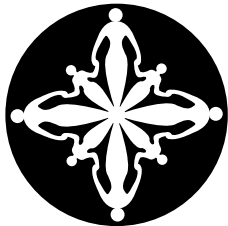




MISSION STATEMENT:

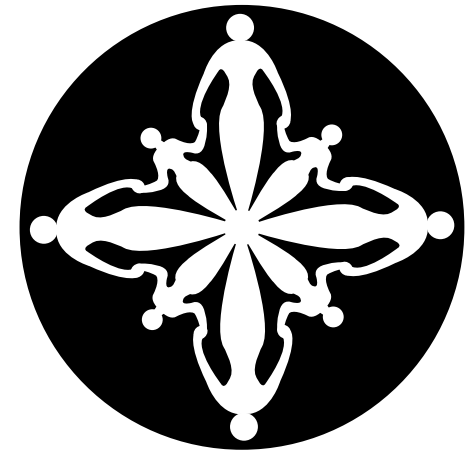

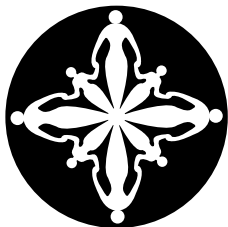
What is TAPP?

WE CAN ASSIST YOU TO:

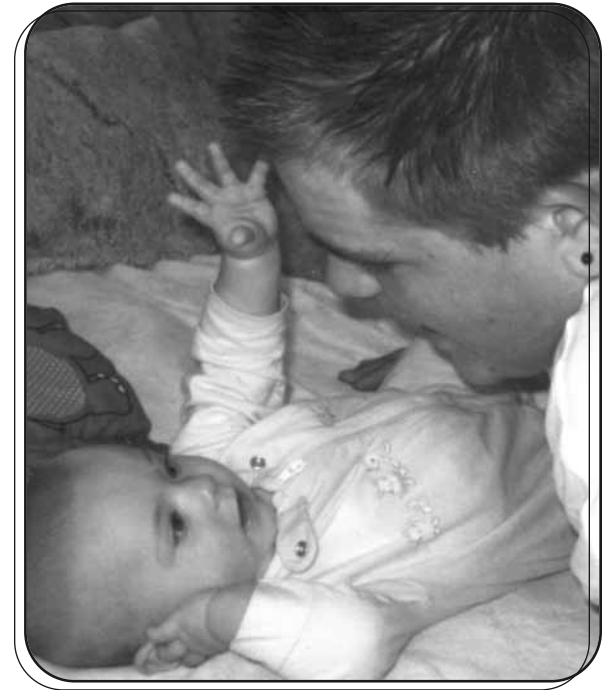
- Obtain the necessary reproductive and health care services
