

MEDI-CAL

Medi-Cal is California's Medicaid program. This is a public health insurance program which provides needed health care services for low-income individuals including families with children, seniors, persons with disabilities, foster care, pregnant women, and low income people with specific diseases such as tuberculosis, breast cancer or HIV/AIDS. Medi-Cal is financed equally by the State and federal government.



Persons who may qualify include:

- Children
- Low-income families
- Childless adults with low incomes
- Seniors over the age of 65

Access to free quality health coverage in San Luis Obispo County

State and county health programs like Medi-Cal are essential for families and individuals who are experiencing hardship. Even if you are working, own a home, or are married, you and your family may qualify for one of these affordable health care alternatives.

Eligibility is based on:

Number of people in your household	Annual Household Income	
	Medi-Cal	Covered California Premium Assistance
1	\$16,243	\$16,244–\$47,080
2	\$21,984	\$21,985–\$63,720
3	\$27,725	\$27,726–\$80,360
4	\$33,465	\$33,466–\$97,000

Assistance can also be provided to individuals who receive Renewal of Enrollment (**re-enrollment**) letters from the Dept. of Social Services that entail income verification and include requests for any changes such as addresses, phone numbers, etc.

Who can get Medi-Cal?

- Low-income families (see table on the left)
- Children under the age of 21
- Low-income families with children under 21 who have an absent, deceased, unemployed or incapacitated parent
- Pregnant women
- Persons 65 or older
- Persons who are blind or disabled
- Persons receiving nursing home care
- Childless adults with low incomes

What do I need to apply?

So we can better serve you, please bring any of the following you have to your appointment:

- Photo ID
- Residency Cards
- Local Mailing Address
- Proof of Income (if any)
- Social Security Cards (or knowledge of SS numbers) for entire family

If you do not have all of these documents, you can still apply!
